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

really looking at the long term."



eil Walker, 26 was the Pittsburgh Pirates first round draft pick in 2004. He is the son of former major league pitcher Tom Walker. Neil is a Pittsburgh native and attended Pine-Richland High School in Gibsonia. He graduated in 2004 as a star catcher on the baseball team and an outstanding wide receiver for the football team. Neil's baseball jersey, #24, was retired from Pine Richland during a pre-game ceremony before the Pittsburgh Pirates' July 22, 2010 game.

After playing nearly every position on the diamond from catcher to the outfield, Walker finally settled in with the team as a second-baseman. "I always believed in my abilities, but there were times when I didn't know where [what position] I'd end up. Second base is probably the last position I'd ever thought I'd be. Last year, I wasn't even sure I was in the right spot, half the time." Walker admitted. "I don't have to worry about six different positions now. I can just focus on just getting better."

Walker hit his first career Major League grand slam on opening day, April 1, 2011 in the 5th inning off Chicago Cubs starter Ryan Dempster, joining Roberto Clemente as the only Pirates players to hit a grand slam on opening day. On May 20, Walker's bobblehead night at PNC Park, he drove in a careerhigh 5 RBI's against the Detroit Tigers in a 10-1 Pirate win. Keep it going Neil....remember "we are the City of Champions!"





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stablished in 2005 by winemaker and co-owner, Mac McLelland partnered with Quarry Hill Orchards, Gill Gammie, who together created a very unique winery environment that has the ambiance worthy of the award winning wines that Mac is know for.

Quarry Hill Winery offers a wide variety of estate grown wines, including Pinot Noir, Pinot Grigio, Riesling, Gewurztraminer, Blaufrankisch, Cabernet Franc, Vidal blanc (used for Ice Wine), Petite Sirah, and their latest experiment Nebbiolo, used to make the high quality, Italian Barolo wines.

The Berlin Heights, Ohio vineyard was planted on the highest point of the farm with a distant view of Lake Erie. This area was once referred to as "The Pinnacle." The vineyard's peak sits at 834' above sea level, which is 100' + higher than the surrounding areas along the lake. You can actually count sailboats from the winery on clear days. The elevation of the vineyard, along with its proximity of 3 miles to Lake Erie, gives the vines added protection from spring frosts and allows longer ripening time for its fruit. As well, the rolling land, and sandy loam soil provides excellent drainage and the nutrients necessary for proper fruit growing.

We must admit that we were pleasantly surprised at the quality and selection at Quarry Hill. We had the misconception that Lake Erie wines are all sweet, which we quickly found out was simple not true. We tasted the Cabernet Franc and found it to be absolutely a top notch. The Quarry Hill Cabernet Franc had low tannin levels and a very distinct berry flavor. We found it an excellent choice to pair with poultry or any Italian dish.

We also sampled the Riesling and found it to crisp with refreshing character,





it was a well-balanced blend of acidity and residual sugar, not too sweet with makes it a perfect pairing to a limitless assortment of food options, make Riesling one of the most versatile wines on the planet.

Quarry Hill's wine bar's kitchen offers a light food menu to compliment the wines. They have a barrel wine cellar and viewing area of the winery. The winery offers both indoor and outdoor seating, a beautiful stone fireplace, granite tasting bar with a 50 inch TV to view select sporting events, plus they have live music every weekend, and an amazing panoramic view of the orchards and vineyards. You literally are sitting in the middle of their vineyard & orchard looking out at the valley below.! Amazing view!

Kelleys Island Venture Resort



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
Miller's Ferry




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ince the moment they appeared on the scene in the early 90's, Stone Temple Pilots dominated the decade from start to finish, racking up 15 singles on the Billboard Top Ten, winning a "Best Hard Rock Performance" GRAMMY in 1994 for for "Plush," and having their five albums sell more than 35 million copies worldwide. Of all their peers, STP alone had sustained commercial success, earning greater critical acclaim with each release, building a body of work that remains popular and its enduring acclaim has only highlighted the absence of the band, who quietly went their separate ways after the turn-of the millennium release of Shangri-La Dee Da. Despite the presence of the greatest hits album Thank You in 2003, there has been a generation that has never witnessed the live power of the vocalist Scott Weiland, guitarist Dean DeLeo, bassist Robert DeLeo and drummer Eric Kretz live in concert, a situation that will be remedied this summer when the band reunites for a long-awaited and highly anticipated tour.

A dominant force in rock music since their inception, the group's impressively extensive and top-selling music has cemented their standing as one of the most successful rock groups of all time. Scott Weiland and Robert DeLeo met at a Black Flag concert in Long Beach, California, discovering in the course of their conversation that the two were dating the same girl. Instead of sparking a rivalry, this common ground was the foundation of a friendship, with the pair moving into the girl's apartment after she left town. Weiland and DeLeo

formed a band called Mighty Joe Young, with drummer Eric Kretz joining the lineup soon afterward, with Robert's brother Dean coming aboard not long after that. Soon, the group established themselves as a draw in San Diego, eventually gaining the attention of Atlantic Records who signed them in 1991. After hearing that there was a blues singer calling himself Mighty Joe Young, the group changed their name to Stone Temple Pilots during the recording of their 1992 debut album, Core.

Core was bracing blend of grunge guitars, classic rock moves and big pop hooks. At first, the ironic swagger of

"Sex Type Thing" brought them onto MTV and radio, but it was "Plush" that blew the doors wide open for the band, establishing them as multi-platinum act in 1993. A pair of subsequent singles were released from Core -- "Wicked Garden" and the spooky, acoustic "Creep" -- before they delivered Purple in 1994. A large, eager fan base snatched Purple up upon its opening week, sending it to # 1 but Purple wasn't a one-week wonder, it grew as the record spun off hit after hit: first there was the majestic, cryptic "Big Empty," taken from The Crow soundtrack, then there was "Vasoline," which was followed by the modern rock classic "Interstate Love Song," a radio smash that stayed on the top of Billboard's Album Rock charts for 15 weeks, besting the record set by the Rolling Stones' "Start Me Up."

Not content to continue to replicate the heavy hooks of their first two albums, Stone Temple Pilots dug deep into glam and Beatleseque psychedelia on their third album, 1996's Tiny Music...Songs from the Vatican Gift Shop, which produced hits in the stomping "Big Bang Baby," tightly-wound "Trippin' on a Hole in a Paper Heart" and beautiful "Lady Picture Show." The band then regrouped for 1999's tough, muscular No. 4, a hard rock album that nevertheless had a wistful highlight in "Sour Girl," which turned into one of STP's biggest hits. Two years later, the group released Shangri-La Dee Da, which achieved a perfect blend of their thick riffs and candy melodies, typified by the hit "Days of the Week."

Stone Temple Pilots went their separate ways after Shangri-La Dee Da, leaving the question of a reunion hanging in the air. A greatest hits album called Thank You in 2003 only reminded fans that all great bands have a certain magic that is attained when the original lineup comes together to play, something Stone Temple Pilots will prove that this summer when they reunite for this long-awaited tour.

In Spring 2008 STP officially revealed that the band will be reuniting and will launch a massive 2008 concert tour encompassing over 65 dates and hitting all corners of North America. Marking the first national tour for Stone Temple Pilots in almost eight years, the 65 date stretch will bring the iconic band's charismatic musicianship and exhilarating live shows to amphitheatres across North America.

The band enjoyed the experience of being back together and performing that they decided to bring the magic back in to the studio. They are now hard at work on a brand new album set for release later this year. STP recently took a short break to hit the road for a 12-city U.S. tour and are planning more dates for the fall.







Pancer changes a family forever, but a diagnosis of pancreatic cancer begins a journey that over 44,000 people will take this year, and nearly 38,000 will die from. This is the exact journey that began in May 2006 for Andrea Bauer and her family. Andrea's mother Kathy was diagnosed with advanced stage pancreatic cancer at the age of 56 and was given little hope, except to go home and get her affairs in order. Six short months later, the pancreatic cancer journey ended, as Kathy lost her battle to the deadly disease. The backbone of her family, the loss of Kathy impacted more than just family, it was a loss for all those around her as Kathy was a school teacher for 34 years and was very active within their community.

"After my mother's death, I knew that something had to be done about this disease and I wanted to become involved with an organization that was actively changing the future of pancreatic cancer", said the Pittsburgh resident. Andrea started volunteering with the Pittsburgh affiliate of the Pancreatic Cancer Action Network (www.pancan.org) in 2008 and currently serves as the Media Representative for the affiliate.



The Pancreatic Cancer Action Network, with 65 affiliates nationwide, is a national organization creating hope in a comprehensive way through research, patient support, community outreach and advocacy for a cure. Pancreatic cancer is the fourth leading cause of cancer death in the United States and has the lowest survival rate of any major cancer, as 74 percent of patients die within the first year and only 6 percent survive more than five years.

The Pancreatic Cancer Action Network has a goal to double the survival rate for pancreatic cancer by 2020 to 12 percent. One of the ways the organization is working to achieve this goal is through raising funds at affiliate events across the country, including signature "PurpleStride" run and walk events.

The Pittsburgh affiliate will host PurpleStride Pittsburgh on August 14, 2011 at the North Park Swimming Pool Lot. The 5k run/walk and 1 mile walk is planned entirely by local volunteers and will raise awareness and much needed funds to fight this devastating disease.

In 2005, what started as a simple rash would lead Wes Semple, a school teacher, to the most unique journey in his life. A few days after the rash appeared, a school nurse noticed his eyes were yellow and urged him to call his doctor. Within a few days, Wes was admitted to the hospital and taken into surgery on Good Friday 2005. Within a few days, the doctor gave Wes the shocking news that he had pancreatic cancer.

After another surgery and 28 days in the hospital, Wes was sent home for six weeks of chemotherapy and radiation. Five months after surgery, Wes attended his first walk in Pittsburgh to benefit the Pancreatic Cancer Action Network. Since then, Wes has been a vital part of the Pittsburgh affiliate, volunteering at events throughout the year and organizing the survivors tent each year at PurpleStride.

On Good Friday this year, Wes celebrated his six year anniversary as a pancreatic cancer survivor. Since his diagnosis Wes still starts and ends each day looking at a small framed plaque on his dresser that states "Nothing is more important than this moment."




should be a masculine or a feminine noun. Each group was asked to give four reasons for its recommendation.

SUMMER OF 57:


