It's Playoff Push Time . . .

What a conundrum of a first half of the NHL season for the Penguins. Mumps, cancer, blood clots, surgeries and the usual bumps and bruises that land hockey players on the scratch list have defined much of their first 46 games. Did I mention the mumps? Every time you turned around someone was getting tested, quarantined and diagnosed with that contagion. Sidney Crosby's mumps face probably gave little kids nightmares. Pascal Dupuis and Olli Maatta are done for the season, Chris Kunitz and

Paul Martin both missed eight games, Kris Letang is concussed, Patric Hornqvist and Blake Comeau have been out 13 and 14 games respectively...and counting.

But at least Beau Bennett is lacing them up after missing October and then nearly all of December. Knock on wood.

Captain Sidney Crosby had a stretch of 29 games where he only scored four goals. Yes, the same guy that had a 25 game goal scoring streak where he notched 50 points back in 2010. The NHL's leading scorer last season. The owner of two Art Ross trophies, to be exact. When you watch him, he doesn't look like the same guy on the ice. Is that because of injury? Because of losing top line mates left and right? Who knows. What we do know is that the Penguins dropped six of their last eight games going into the All Star weekend and both Crosby and Evgeni Malkin didn't make the trip to Columbus because of lower body injuries. Crud.

It feels like the Penguins are having a crummy season, doesn't it? Like playoff success is an iffy proposition if they keep playing like this. But in reality, it's not as gloomy as it feels. Crosby did snap out of his scoring funk with four goals in his last six games leading up to the break. The team has racked up 60 points, good for fifth in the Eastern Conference and second behind Tampa Bay in the Metropolitan Division. Marc Andre Fleury is having a banner year. And even though the power play has slumped big time, you gotta think that the only place to go from there is up.


The Pens reignite their season post All Star break playing four games in six days, including a back to back set of games versus the Winnipeg Jets at home and then onto DC to play the Capitals right off the bat. They can get right back into the swing of things - like the win column - quickly and generate some momentum for the second half of the season. Who is the guy that I think can make things happen? David Perron. Actually it's two guys. Perron



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and Hornqvist, when he is healthy, back on the ice.

When GM Jim Rutherford sets his sights on a target, he typically hits it. Need a little more mucking it up and grinding it out? Hello Patric Hornqvist. Before he was hurt, he was nearly a point per game player (29 points in 33 games). Scoring wingers dropping like flies? You want a first round pick for 26 year old David Perron, one year removed from a 28 goal season? You got it. Rutherford goes and gets what he wants - or as in this case, needs - and you have to respect the man for that. Despite scoring just five goals in 38 games before joining the Penguins, Rutherford knew Perron was an elite center away from being a big time contributor. And wouldn't you know it, he had two of those kinda guys who were looking for a sharp shooter. Voila! Perron doubled his goal total, scoring five times in his first eight games with the Penguins. Add in his two assists and he is also nearly a point per game player.

It's easy to see the potential in David Perron. He modeled his game after his boyhood idol, known for his career as a Canadien but had a cup of coffee in Pittsburgh as well, Alexi Kovalev. It's evident each time Perron takes a shot on goal. Lightning quick hands and nimble wrists. If he continues to bloom, and Hornqvist plays at the same level he did before his lower body injury sidelined him, the Penguins will have a lot of firepower at their disposal. Hornqvist will help lagging special teams, he is fourth on the team with four power play goals, not to mention add some muscle to the crease. He scores a lot of dirty goals and sometimes one of those put backs off a rebound can be the difference between a win and a loss.

Getting healthy is the biggest key to second half success for the Penguins. Having an exorbitant amount of man games lost is nothing new to the team and they again rank towards the top of the NHL in that category this year. Another thing that is nothing new? Short playoff runs. Think there is a correlation between the two? I do. The last five Stanley Cup winners - the LA Kings, Chicago Blackhawks and Boston Bruins - were the least impacted by man games lost the last five years.

The Penguins season has been full of ups and downs already, but they are positioned well to make a move in the standings and once healthy, the playoffs.

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
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PyroFest 2015 – Expanding to a Two

While chocolaty and fruity beers aren't necessarily meant for Valentine's Day, the day gives us a great excuse to look for a dark, delicious beer. The colder weather lends itself to these beers as well, and with Valentine's Day being in February, it's a perfect time to enjoy some great beer.

Forget the truffles, chocolate boxes, and bottles of wine for Valentine's Day and stick with these seven beers instead. From chocolate stouts to banana bread beer, there's something in this list for everyone. It doesn't matter if you're spending Valentine's Day with that special someone or going it alone, these beers will make the day better either way. Before getting into the beers though, let's take a look at what exactly makes a chocolate beer taste like chocolate.

What Makes a Chocolate Beer?

So what makes a beer chocolate? The easy answer is chocolate of course, but the truth goes far deeper than this. For starters, most chocolate beers you'll find are of the stout or porter variety. These beers use a mix of roasted malts to give you the taste and color you expect from these beers. Add to this some specialized chocolate malt and you start to get some amazing bittersweet chocolate aromas and tastes without adding a single piece of actual chocolate.

A good brewer can adjust these ingredients to add in tastes of cocoa as well still without straying from the basic four ingredients of beer. To make a chocolate beer extra delicious though, many breweries add in chocolate in the form of cocoa nibs, cocoa powder, and actual chocolate of both the sweet and bittersweet variety.

These tastes can be played with to achieve the exact mix of flavors and aromas the brewer wants, which can run the gamut from hints of chocolate to full-on sweetness and chocolate syrup flavors that could easily make a beer float with ice cream!

Chocolate beers are the perfect fit for Valentine's Day, giving you your dose of alcohol and chocolate in one hit. Even if you're not a big fan of dark beers, or beer in general, each of these are definitely worth a try. We're even including a beer cocktail you can mix up yourself and a beer that's neither chocolate nor dark in case you want to try something different, too. Grab one of the beers listed below and enjoy Valentine's Day with friends or that special someone. Either way, it's a good night for some great beer.



Southern Tier Choklat Stout

Chocolate has long been the go-to gift for Valentine's Day and for good reason. Chocolate tastes great and triggers the happy parts of your brain to make you feel great, too. Southern Tier Brewing decided to take a heavy dose of bittersweet chocolate and add it to a 10% ABV stout in hopes of making that feeling and taste even better.

Expect to taste chocolate, dark cherries, hints of vanilla, and a light woodiness in this beer, as well as a hint of alcoholic burn from the 10% ABV. Choklat from Southern Tier has some bitterness but it's backed up very well with the chocolate and maltiness of the beer. If you're enjoying one of these big bottles for Valentine's Day make sure to take it out of the fridge a little bit before enjoying, as it's best enjoyed around 48 F.

Sam Smith Organic Chocolate Stout

If you like your chocolate beers on the sweet side then Samuel Smith Organic Chocolate Stout is about as perfect as they come. This beer starts out life as a milk stout, which means it's creamier than your average beer and a little sweet from the get-go. The brewers at Samuel Smith add to this a healthy dose of cocoa that, when paired with the sweetness of a milk stout, gives the impression of a sweet chocolaty drink.

Even before you taste this beer, the aroma is all about the chocolate. One whiff and your mouth will start watering. Surprisingly enough, even though this seems like a heavier beer, it is very approachable and doesn't wear on you like some other sweeter beers might do.

You can take this one step further and add in some Lindeman's Kriek to your Organic Chocolate Stout and make your own drinkable chocolate covered cherry! Play with the percentages to get it just how you like it, but you'll probably want more stout than Kriek in your mix.

Boulder Shake Porter


Who doesn't love a chocolate shake, right? While Boulder's Shake Porter isn't quite a chocolate shake in the traditional sense, theirs comes in at 5.9% ABV and starts off with a huge aroma that's all chocolate. You'll immediately smell cacao nibs on the nose of the beer as well as some nuttiness.

As for the taste, you should notice a nice creamy body and mouthfeel on this beer with a somewhat sweet malty taste and a slightly dry finish. Chocolate and nuttiness definitely come through in the taste and bring along with them some coffee, toastiness, and even a little toffee on the finish.

Just like most darker beers, let this one warm up just a little and you'll be rewarded with more subtle tastes and aromas as it warms. Porters aren't known for being beers that people get excited about, but the balance of chocolate and bitterness in Shake Porter give it something to definitely be excited about.

Young's Double Chocolate Stout

Possibly one of the most well known chocolate stouts, Young's Double Chocolate Stout hails from the United Kingdom and





is most often found in tall cans that feature nitrogen widgets. The nitrogen in this beer makes it extra creamy and delicious and the can helps to protect the beer from light so you get the best beer possible.

Double Chocolate Stout starts out as a sweet milk stout before the chocolate is added. At 5.2% ABV this beer is easy enough to drink while keeping a huge amount of flavor. When you pour this beer the first thing you'll notice is the aroma that's dominated by cocoa powder and semi-sweet chocolate. While this beer has hops in it, there is little to no trace in the aroma.

Brewed with pale, crystal, and chocolate malt as well as real dark chocolate and traditional British hops, Double Chocolate Stout is definitely a beer anyone who loves stouts or chocolate needs to try.

At first taste you'll notice the same chocolate in the aroma carrying through nicely to the taste. While the beer has a creamy mouthfeel, it's far from heavy, which is great for being able to drink more than one. The taste is definitely chocolate but not overpowering and not overly sweet like some others. In short, it's a well-balanced beer that features chocolate.

Rogue Chocolate Stout

While sweet chocolate beers are great, sometimes those of us that love a good bitter beer are left out in the cold.

Thankfully Rogue Brewing took up the challenge to make a chocolate beer with a healthy dose of bitterness and the result is their award-winning Chocolate Stout.

The aroma from this stout is all about the malt, as it is very toasted malt-forward with a smell reminiscent of a caramel macchiato. The bitter chocolate aroma comes through in the end of the nose, and carries right through to the taste.


Ebony in color and with a rich, creamy head, Chocolate Stout features an earthy flavor that comes from oats and the hop varieties used to give this beer more than your standard chocolate flavor. This beer finishes with the tastes of a rich chocolate truffle that's been sprinkled with cocoa powder.

While this beer definitely has chocolate in the ingredient list, a good bit of the chocolate flavor comes from the chocolate malt that's used in the brewing process, which also helps to give the beer its dark color full body.

Chocolate Stout from Rogue Brewing comes in at 6% ABV and has a respectable 69 IBUs.

Yard's Love Stout

What could be better to enjoy on Valentine's Day than a beer that actually has Love in the name? Love Stout from Yards Brewing in Philadelphia is brewed with roasted malts that give the beer a bittersweet chocolate flavor. While this beer has a



chocolate aroma and taste, there isn't any added chocolate in this beer. All that aroma and taste comes from the blend of roasted and chocolate malts.

The mix of malts also helps to give this 5.5% ABV beer a full body without seeming thick, and the bitterness is kept in check so you get to experience the semi-sweet nature of the beer.

Love Stout was introduced in 1997 but didn't hit it big until recently with the reintroduction of 12-ounce bottles this year. Love Stout is the perfect beer for Valentine's Day and pairs exceedingly well with oysters as well as soft cheeses, winter stews, and especially some sweet treats.

Wells Banana Bread

Don't you just love the smell of a warm loaf of banana bread cooking in the oven? Better yet, the taste of that amazing bread is enough to make your mouth water. Wells took this idea and combined it with their traditional beers to make something that truly is the best of both worlds in one amazing beer.

Wells Banana Bread Beer comes in at 5.2% ABV features a ripe banana flavor with just a hint of bitterness. This beer keeps all the banana flavor and aroma without being overly sweet. The aroma is all bready banana thanks to the malts used in brewing mixing with the real fair-trade bananas used in the brewing process. The taste is a perfect blend of banana, malt, and just a slight bit of hops. Each works with the other to give a blended, balanced taste that isn't too harsh in any direction.

A World Of Beers

With so many amazing craft beers in the United States, it's easy to forget that around the world outstanding beers are brewed, many of them having recipes that date back more than one hundred years or more.

This means that beyond our borders there's a world of beer just waiting for us. Thankfully you don't have to travel the world to try these beers, but instead all you have to do is find a good beer bar or distributor that loves foreign beer and try them for yourself. From sweet and fruity Belgians to crisp and dry lagers, there's a lot of beer out there, all you have to do is look.

Much of the beer in European countries is of the lager variety while many of the most popular beers in the US are ales, like the IPA. Pilsners started in Europe, so it's no surprise that these beers are still the most popular in many areas there. These beers tend to be light and refreshing with a sharp hop bite and a bready, malty backbone.

This isn't to say that these are the only beers you'll find around the world, but they are definitely common in Europe. There's an enormous variety of beers outside of the United States, so many that it can be hard to determine which is the best, and what you'll like.

Lucky for you, we went ahead and found some breweries from around the world that make a variety of beers so you can get a little more worldly in your drinking and take a trip around the world in your pint glass.

Fullers – England

Fuller's Brewery is an independent family brewery that was founded in 1845 in the Cheshire area of London, England. Known as the Griffin Brewery, Fuller's is London's only remaining family brewery, making it something we love here in the US.

While the brewery makes a variety of beers for sale around the world, we're most familiar with their London Pride ale. This beer has been brewed by Fuller's since 1950 and features a well-rounded flavor that takes full advantage of excellent hop and malt bills.

Hacker-Pschorr – Germany

Located in Munich, Hacker-Pschorr was started in 1972 when two breweries, the Hacker and Pschorr breweries to be exact, merged. The history in this brewery goes back far more than 1972 though, as the Hacker Brewery was formed in 1417, almost 100 years before the Reinheitsgebot purity law of 1516!

In the US we generally see three of this brewery's offerings in the way of Munich Gold, Original Oktoberfest,



and Weisse. Munich Gold is a golden lager that has a full body and mild taste, and is possibly the most popular offering from the brewery in the US. Their Original Oktoberfest is a true Oktoberfest lager that's brewed for the yearly celebration in Munich. Weisse is their wheat beer offering that features refreshing fruity and citrus notes while keeping a dry finish.

Weltenburger Monastery – Germany

When it comes to brewing history, few breweries can top the history of monastery breweries. The Weltenburger Monastery Brewery started making beer in 1050 AD, giving it nearly 1,000 years of brewing history!

The brewery makes a fairly wide assortment of beers, with their most popular being the Weltenburger Kloster Barock Dunkel. This beer won the World Beer Cup award for best dunkel beer in 2004, 2008, and 2012. The monastic brewery is located on the Danube River, and features a large restaurant on the ground floor that focuses on traditional Bavarian dining.

Baltika – Russia


Baltika Brewery started brewing beer in 1990, but it wasn't until 1992 that the beer started being sold under the actual company's name. Baltika is the best-selling beer in Russia, and is the second largest in terms of sales in all of Europe. In fact, Baltika accounts for more than 70% of all Russian beer!

Baltika exports their beer to more than 45 countries and has 10 breweries. In short, they're a pretty big deal in Europe. Thankfully they make some pretty good beer. In the US we mostly drink their Baltika Lager and Baltika Porter.

Früli- Belgium

Produced near Ghent in Belgium, Früli is an extra-sweet strawberry beer that starts its life as a white ale before strawberry juice is added. Früli is distributed around the world and here in the US it's enjoyed mostly in bottles. If you're looking for a completely different and unique beer, Früli might be worth a try.

Brewdog- Scotland

Hailing from Scotland, BrewDog is more what we in the US think of when we talk about craft beer. The brewery aims at a more domestic variety of beers including their Punk IPA and Libertine Black Ale.

BrewDog recently made their reappearance in the Pittsburgh area, and we couldn't be happier.

Golden Pheasant- Slovakia

Founded in 1967 and located in Hurbano-vo, Slovakia the Golden Pheasant Brewery makes some of the best beer around, and the most popular beer in all of Slovakia.

Their signature lager speaks to the tastes of the original lagers produced in this part of Europe, and their recipes harken back to these age-old recipes. The result is great beer that has a direct tie to true beer history.

Lasko Brewery – Slovenia

Lasko brewery holds the title of the largest brewery in Slovenia, and was founded in 1825 by Franz Geyer. The brewery is named after the town in which it resides.

The brewery makes traditional lagers that are crisp, fresh, and all-around great. The choice of hops and malt gives these lagers a unique taste that sets them apart from other beers found throughout Europe, and harken back to the original lagers of Europe.

Brunehaut – Belgium

For those of us that can't have gluten but still want an amazing beer, the offerings from Brunehaut Brewery are perfect. Their artisanal Belgian ale is both organic and gluten free, making it perfect for the gluten-free people of the world.

Technically speaking, these beers are gluten-reduced, as they start with traditional barley and through a special process the ten is removed, leaving an amazing beer safe to drink whether you can have gluten or not.

Karlovacko – Croatia

While we may not get a lot of Croatian beer in the US, Karlovacko produces an amazing Czech Pilsener in their namesake beer. Like many pilsners, this beer features slight grassy aroma and taste and a sharp hop taste. If European lagers are your thing, this is one you definitely need to try.

Obolon – Ukraine

The Obolon Brewery located in Ukraine produces a variety of beers available around the world. In the US we're most familiar with their traditional lager. This highly rated European lager is fresh, crisp, and perfectly balanced between hops and malt to give it a true lager taste.

Primator Lager - Czech Republic

Coming out of the Czech Republic, Primator Premium Lager is a great example of a Czech Pilsener at 5% ABV. This beer has the golden color and fresh hop aroma and taste you expect, but with a slight sweet banana-ish flavor thanks to the yeast used in the brewing process.

Zywiec – Poland

The Zywiec (pronounced zivvek) Brewery was founded in 1852 in Zywiec, Poland. The brewery produces a variety of beers ranging from 5.6% ABV to 9.5% and above. Most common in the US is their Zywiec Beer, which is a light lager. We also get their Porter, which is a 9.5% ABV beer that's dark and malty.

Asahi – Japan

Hailing from Japan, Asahi's most popular beer is their Super Dry, a lager that's crisp, clear, and refreshing. Asahi Super Dry is Japan's most popular beer, and is found on just about every good Japanese restaurant menu.

Cooper's Ale's – Australia

Finishing out our list of beers around the world, we stop in Australia and their famous Cooper's Brewery. Cooper's makes a variety of ales, but their most notable is their Original Pale Ale. This is an English-style pale ale that comes in at 4.5% ABV. It's earthy hop profile is backed up nicely by a strong malt backbone, making it a true traditional English Pale Ale.

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Nightwire Takes You To The Movies - Mr. Turner

Based upon the life and career of the great British painter J.M.W. Turner (1775-1851) played by Timothy Spall. The film is a British, French and German biographical drama film, written and directed by Mike Leigh, and starring Timothy Spall, Dorothy Atkinson, Paul Jesson, Marion Bailey, Lesley Manville and Martin Savage. It premiered in competition for the Palme d'Or at the 2014 Cannes Film Festival, where Spall won the award for Best Actor and cinematographer Dick Pope received a special jury prize for the film's cinematography.

Leigh has described Turner as "a great artist: a radical, revolutionary painter", explaining: "I felt there was scope for a film examining the tension between this very mortal, flawed individual, and the epic work, the spiritual way he had of distilling the world".

Although known for art Turner, the artist is regarded as one of the founders of English watercolor landscape painting. Some of most famous J. M. W. Turner paintings are Calais Pier, Dido Building Carthage, Rain, Steam and Speed, Burial at Sea, and The Grand Canal, Venice.

The film focuses on the last quarter century of the Mr. Turner's life. He was profoundly affected by the death of his esteemed father, loved by his housekeeper, Hannah Danby, whom he takes for granted and occasionally exploits sexually, he forms a close relationship with a seaside landlady with whom he eventually lives incognito in Chelsea, where he eventually dies. He has an estranged ex-wife to whom he has two daughters, but when asked if has any children, he replies, "no."

Throughout the film, Turner travels, paints, stays with the country aristocracy. He visits a brothel and is a popular anarchic member of the Royal Academy of Arts. In one powerful and unforgettable scene Turner actually has himself strapped to the mast of a ship to experience how it feels so that he can paint a snowstorm. Mr. Turner is a cantankerous, grunting bullfrog, who also happened to be a brilliant

artist, perhaps Britain's finest ever.

Leigh has described Turner as "a great artist: a radical, revolutionary painter", explaining: "I felt there was scope for a film examining the tension between this very mortal, flawed individual, and the epic work, the spiritual way he had of distilling the world".

"Cynicism has no place in the reviewing of art." Words to live by, for sure, and all the more so for being uttered by John Ruskin, one of the giants of 19th-century British art criticism. But nothing is quite so simple. "Mr. Turner," appears as a pretentious carrot-topped nitwit with a voice like a posh Elmer Fudd. In one scene, he offers up "controversial" theories about landscapes and seascapes to a roomful of harrumphing artists. It's all very well, one of them says, to opine and interpret, but unless you have braved the elements with brush in hand, you don't really know what you're talking about.

This film gives you the opportunity to see Mr. Turner's work as it might have looked in its original moment thanks to the brilliant cinematography of Dick Pope, who allows us to see the world as Turner saw it. And as we do, an almost alchemical transformation takes place, as our various sensory and cognitive impressions merge into a thrilling and powerful form of understanding. By the end, we may not be able to summarize Turner's life, explain his paintings or know everything about British history. But we may perhaps find that our knowledge of all those things has deepened, and the way by which we measure our own experience has grown wider. Perhaps our appreciation of art has grown deeper by considering the torment and passion that goes into each piece. A brilliant must see film!

 - You’ve sworn you’re going to have “No Code” tattooed on your chest.



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
