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

Q: Due to my Easter/Passover vacation obligations, a colleague who read my Tax Tips in April volunteered these additional tax-related comments for Nightwire in May.

A. Here are some Tips for Homeowners in particular.

If you ask a group of homeowners the benefits of owning versus renting, they will likely say "the tax deductions" because homeowners who itemize their taxes are able to deduct 100% of their mortgage interest and property taxes from their income tax returns.

That means that if you're in a 28% tax bracket, Uncle Sam effectively subsidizes about a third of your borrowing costs, making your home more affordable or allowing you to buy a larger home than you could otherwise buy. Many closing cost fees are tax deductible as well, and thousands of dollars of profit or capital gains that you realize when you sell your home can be exempt from income taxes.

At tax time, it's critical to know what you're entitled to, so you can claim it. So, here are home-related income tax tips to help you avoid home ownership-related tax traps.

A) One Must Itemize to Claim Deductions

During the recent debate in DC about whether the mortgage interest deduction should be eliminated, it came out that nearly 40% of homeowners lose out on their major tax advantages every year when they fail to itemize their income taxes. If you own a home and otherwise have a fairly simple return, it might be tempting just to take the standard deduction -- and if your mortgage, property taxes and income are low enough, the standard deduction might outweigh your homeowners' deductions. Before you start filling in a 1040-EZ form, ask your mortgage company or TurboTax whether itemizing or taking the standard deduction will result in the lowest tax bill (or the highest tax refund).

B) Home Office Deductions Require Advance Planning

According to the Small Business Administration, the average home office deduction is about \$3,700. So calculate that number in regards to your tax bracket to figure what you'll save on your taxes by writing off your home office. Keep in mind that the space you designate as your home office cannot be exempted from capital gains tax when you sell your home later. The \$250,000 (single)/\$500,000 (married filing jointly) income tax exemption for capital gains is only good on your personal residence. If you foresee selling your home for much more than you bought it, discuss this with your CPA to see if the few hundred bucks you save now is worth the capital gains downside in the future.

C) Limits on Tax Relief for Loan Mods, Short Sales, and Foreclosures

It is projected that 2011 will be a peak year for foreclosures. Distressed homeowners likely to see a short sale, loan modification, or foreclosure should be aware that normally, any mortgage balance that is wiped out by one of these outcomes is taxed as what the IRS calls Cancellation of Debt Income, or CODI.

Under the Mortgage Debt Forgiveness Relief Act of 2007, the



IRS is currently not charging income taxes on CODI incurred through a loan mod, short sale, or foreclosure on most primary residences through 2012. But right now, banks are taking many months to work out mortgages in all of these ways. If you foresee any of these outcomes, don't procrastinate. Do what you can to get to closure on your distressed home/loan while you won't have income taxes to add as the insult on top of your significant housing injury.

D) Refinancing or Property Tax Appeals Can Have Income Tax Consequences

Many people are applying for lower property tax bills due to the recent decline in home values. Those who have equity have sought to refinance 8% home loans to 5% rates recently. These strategies offer large savings for the big investment in time and money. Smart homeowners who slash these costs know that property taxes and mortgage interest are also the basis for the major tax benefits of being a homeowner. So plan ahead for those deductions to go down along with taxes and interest.

E) Closing Costs Can Be Made To Be Financially Beneficial

If you bought/refinanced your home in 2010, not only are your mortgage interest and property tax deductible, but so are your closing costs. Any origination fees or discount points that were paid to your mortgage lender at closing are tax deductible, even if the seller paid your closing costs. Your HUD-1 settlement statement (that legal sized paper full of line item credits and debits that you should have received from your escrow provider or title attorney at Closing) has the info you need..

Chicago an American rock band formed in 1967 in Chicago, Illinois. The band began as a politically charged, sometimes experimental, rock band and later moved to a predominantly softer sound, becoming famous for producing a number of hit ballads. They had a steady stream of hits throughout the 1970s and 1980s. Second only to The Beach Boys in terms of Billboard singles and albums chart success among American bands, Chicago is one of the longest running and most successful pop/rock and roll groups. Chicago re-teamed with producer Phil Ramone in October 2010 to begin work on a new album.

According to Billboard, Chicago was the leading U.S. singles charting group during the 1970s. They have sold over 38 million units in the U.S., with 22 gold, 18 platinum, and 8 multi-platinum albums. Over the course of their career they have charted five No. 1 albums, and have had 21 top ten hits.

Despite the personnel changes over the years, the group is still active four decades after its founding. They are one of the few major rock groups that have never broken up or even taken an extended hiatus. As of June 2010, four of the six surviving founding members (major songwriters Lamm and Pankow, plus Loughnane and Parazaidler) remain

providing continuity, while Jason Scheff has been with the band 25 years, Tris Imboden 20 years, and Keith Howland 15 years.

Elvis Costello has followed his musical curiosity in a career spanning more than 30 years. He is perhaps best known for his performances with The Attractions, The Imposters and for concert appearances with pianist Steve Nieve. However, he has also entered into acclaimed collaborations with Burt Bacharach, The Brodsky Quartet, Paul McCartney, Swedish mezzo-soprano Anne Sofie von Otter, guitarist Bill Frisell, composer Roy Nathanson, The Charles Mingus Orchestra, record producer and songwriter T Bone Burnett and Allen Toussaint.

During his career Costello has received several prestigious honors, including two Ivor Novello Awards for songwriting, a Dutch Edison Award with The Brodsky Quartet for 'The Juliet Letters', the Nordoff-Robbins Silver Clef Award, a BAFTA for the music written with Richard Harvey for Alan Bleasdale's television drama series 'G.B.H.' and a Grammy for "I Still Have That Other Girl" from his 1998 collaboration with Burt Bacharach, 'Painted From Memory'.

Elvis Costello and The Attractions were inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 2003. During the same year he was awarded ASCAP's prestigious Founder's Award. There have also been a number of Grammy nominations for his recent albums 'When I Was Cruel' and 'The Delivery Man'.







Cirque

Totem May 12 - May 29



Cirque du Soleil Share the excitement of the return of Cirque du Soleil in Pittsburgh with its latest Big Top production. Totem premieres May 12, 2011 and runs through May 29 Under the Blue-and-Yellow Grand Chapiteau at 20th Street & A.V.R.R. in the Strip District. Totem is Cirque du Soleil's latest touring show, created and directed by previous collaborator Robert Lepage (Kà). Cirque du Soleil describes Totem's theme as the evolution of mankind from its primordial, amphibian state toward the aspiration of flight, taking inspiration from many of mankind's founding myths.

Set and technical information

Cirque du Soleil used interactive projection technologies to enhance and provide variety to the types of scenes created for Totem, including swamps, starry nights, lakes, volcanoes, and other natural environments. The kinetic images are created with the help of infrared cameras; the projection system can dynamically create projections, making it seem as if they are reacting to the artists' movements in both real-time and pre-recorded sequences. One of the major elements for the set is the large turtle carapace, which functions as both a decorative piece as well as acrobatic equipment. When not in use, the shell is tilted or raised completely to the top of the tent or

arena. It weighs 2,700 pounds, has two horizontal bars, and is covered in a non-slip finish. Another major component of the set is the "scorpion bridge", which functions as an entrance at times. It is made of 10,000 pounds of steel and has eight mineral oil hydraulic motors which allow it to move in three dimensions—extending, retracting, curling, etc. Underneath said bridge is housing for a laser, speakers, lighting equipment, and cameras. Movement of the scorpion bridge is controlled by an operator who uses four infrared cameras. Of final note, the marsh reeds at the back of the stage are actually inflatable, which allows for easier transport between performance locations.

Equipment and props which are not part of the set have been just as carefully planned out and created. The unicycles are 7 feet tall, but are very light for better maneuverability. Similarly, the perch poles are made of duralumin, the largest of which is 33 feet tall. In total summation, Totem utilizes 65 tractor-trailer sized containers to transport its 1,200 tons of equipment from site to site.

According to Melanie Lalande, Artistic Director for Totem there are fifty-two performing artists from 18 countries. The Cirque casting department travels all over the world to



ultimately find the finest and best talent in the world. The total number of people, who travel with Totem is 150. There is a full kitchen and the chefs daily create 3 meals a day for people from 18 different countries. Their meals are very high quality, healthy, delicious and nutritious.

From concept to design it took approximately 2 years and another 6 months to get ready for the show. There was a team of 24 people working together to design Totem.

Melanie is the talent and brains behind the scenes with her staff of eleven she orchestrates Totem like a sports game, from lighting to sound, she does it all making Totem one super spectacular flawless show.

Costumes

As Totem's storyline includes the evolution of mankind, inspiration for the 779 costume elements came directly from nature. Costume designer Kym Barrett primarily focused on how to treat various fabrics rather than the materials themselves in order to replicate the elements found in nature. Such treatments included advanced printing techniques, fluorescent pigments, and utilizing mirror fragments and crystals for adornment. Below is more detailed information about specific costume pieces and the wardrobe collection as a whole.

The Crystal Man's stretch velvet leotard is encrusted with nearly 4,500 reflective components; 4,001 are mirror fragments. This costume is the show's heaviest, weighing eight pounds.

The foot juggling duo's lycra body stockings are each adorned with 3,500 crystals, and each headpiece has another 1,000.

The hoop dancer's costume is inspired by not one traditional Native American tribe, but by several. For instance it includes a Hopi cross and headdress.


Final Assignment



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
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
